

aloe vera, amrapali, vanilla, black pepper etc. for making the forest dwellers economically self-reliant and the forest department should handhold the farmers till the trees become productive. He was also in favour of cultivating same crop in a particular area considering its marketing feasibility and other aspects. He said this while addressing a review meeting of the forest department yesterday at the state secretariat.

In view of the construction of targeted 288 dams by the department the Chief Minister advised to work in convergence with fishery, rural development, animal resource development, irrigation etc. departments and stressed on tightening vigilance by the forest department for better protection of forest resources. The Forest Minister Mewar Kumar Jamatia also shed light on various programmes of the forest department.

Principal chief conservator of forest Dr. Alind Rastogi talked about various activities of the department. Discussion during the meeting also hovered around main activities of the department, strategy, current action plan, target and achievement, infrastructure, revenue collection, rate of tourist arrival, wildlife in Sepahijala sanctuary, new plans, last three years statistics etc. issues. The matter of marketing of *arjun* flower and ensuring

reasonable price to the collectors and sellers also came up discussion. The meeting was also attended by the chief secretary L.K. Gupta, additional principal chief conservator Dr. D.K. Sharma, forest officers of eight districts and other line department officers.
