With the objective of reaching out to the people of remote areas with administrative facilities an administrative-cum-health camp was organised at Mendi ADC village in Salema block of Kamalpur subdivision yesterday. In the camp people 126 recevied PRTC, 143 people received ST certificate and 85 people received marriage registration certificate. Besides, 36 people availed health check-up and medicines.

### **GPDP workshop in Udaipur** to chalk-out future strategies

Under the aegis of panchayat department a daylong workshop on Gram Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) was held yesterday at Panchayati Raj Training Centre, Udaipur. Panchayat secretaries, GRS and representatives of various departments were present there. The discussion in the workshop included assessment of the activities 2019-20 financial year, gramsabha meeting, socio-economic development of gram panchayat and village committee areas etc. In addition, panchayat officer Shanti Ranjan Chakma, assistant director Ratan Nama, Bipul Barman and panchayat extension officers deliberated in detail on how to chalk-out the plan of development for gram panchayats for the 2020-21 financial year.

## 40 Fish farmer families to get houses in Jampuijala

Under the initiative the fisheries department houses will be constructed for 40 fish farmer families of four ADC villages in Jampuijala subdivision during the 2019-20 financial year. Among the beneficiaries 10 will be from Pekuarjala ADC village, 10 families from Pranbhapur ADC village, 10 families from Madhya Ghaniamara ADC village and 10 families from Tuima ADC village. An amount of Rs. 1.30 lakh will be spent in construction of each house, informed a source of the Jampuijala fishery supervisor's office.

Ayushman Bharat completes one year – all beneficiaries to receive e-Card by March, 2020 Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana has completed one year of its implementation. On this note the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb has directed the officials of the health department to provide e-Card to all the beneficiaries of this scheme by March, 2020. This includes 3.57 lakh beneficiaries of Ayushman Tripura Yojana. To mark the occasion a special programme was organised at Pragna Bhavan recently. Addressing the audience there the chief minister stated that this scheme will not only benefit the patients but also it will bring income to the hospitals.

On this occasion the chief minister said, the state government is working on several plans and strategies to improve health services in the state. Recently Atal Behari Bajpayee Regional Cancer Hospital was inaugurated in Agartala, he mentioned. For this purpose the central government provided an amount of Rs. 120 crore. Initiative has been taken to install required machineries in this hospital.

Shedding light on the provisions of Ayushman Bharat the secretary of health department Dr. Debasis Basu said, it has two components, one is establishment of health and wellness centre and another is provision of upto Rs. 5 lakh in cash for treatment of poor families. At present there are 1020 sub-health centres in the state. Out of them, 300 sub-health centres have been converted to health and wellness centre. The government has a target to

convert rest of the sub-health centres into health and wellness centres by the year 2022. These health and wellness centres are meant to provide diagnosis, testing facility and free medicines after that.

Additionally the working secretary of Tripura Swasthya Suraksha Samiti Aditi Majumder informed that apart from observance of Ayushman Bharat Day alongwith the rest of the country the state has also observed Ayushman Bharat Fortnight from September 14-20. About 20.57 lakh people of the state have been brought under the scheme and till now 5 lakh beneficiaries have received e-Card. Sixty-two government hospitals and two private hospitals of the state have been enlisted under the scheme and from these hospitals beneficiaries are receiving 1551 types of health services and surgery packages.
