







Khumpui Ter at Tuikambha market from February 8-9

Two-day Khumpui Ter will be held at Tuikambha market of Satchand block from February 8-9. A preparatory meeting was held at the premises of Tuikambha ADC village office to discuss related matters on January 28. It was decided in the meeting that Tribal Welfare Minister Mevar Kumar Jamatia would inaugurate the festival. MLA Shankar Roy and other guests will be present in the festival.

SDM Biplab Das and officials of various departments were present in the meeting. Chairman of Tuikambha ADC village Jabirung Tripura presided over the meeting. Two-day cultural programme will be organized by the ICA department in the festival. A managing committee headed by SDM Biplab Das as convener and chairman of Satchand Block Kheladhan Tripura as chairman has been constituted. Moreover, 5 Sub-committees have been constituted.

Administrative camp held at Demdum

An administrative and health camp was organized by Kumarghat sub-divisional administration at West Demdum SB

School of Demdum ADC village on January 28. Income certificates have been issued to 40 persons on urgent application basis. 82 applications for issuing ST certificate, 84 applications for issuing PRTC and 5 applications for issuing marriage certificate have been received in the camp. Health department provided required medicines after medical checkup of 64 patients. Animal resources development department provided disease preventing medicines to the livestock farmers after treatment of 133 animals and birds. From this camp 27 livestock farmers have benefited. In the camp ROR certificates have been issued to many families of this locality.

Toilets for beneficiaries in Sepahijala district

Under Swachh Bharat Mission (rural) during the current financial year 56,345 toilets have been provided to the beneficiaries of Gomati district. Besides this, under Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) 1528 toilets have been provided to the beneficiaries till now. Out of 173 Gram panchayats and ADC villages of the district, 60 villages have been declared as open defecation free area.
