Speaking on the occasion the chairman of MAKAIS Prof. Sujit K. Ghosh said, two years back the Prime Minister Narendra Modi entrusted this institute with the onus of expanding research works to the Northeastern states and the institute has lined up its programmes accordingly.



Hezamara block, 261 connections in Belbari block and 88 connections in Mandwi block of West Tripura district were given during the current financial year under the scheme. Development activities under MGNREGA in Kanchanpur subdivision

3 lakh 82 thousand 500 mandays have been generated in all ADC villages of Dasda, Jampuihill and Lefunga blocks Kanchanpur subdivision under MGNREGA during the current financial Construction of rural road, cultivation of various cash crop, land levelling etc works have been done under the scheme at the cost of Rs 7 core 34 lakh 40 thousand. 2 lakh 29 thousand 95 mandays have been generated under the scheme in Dasda block at the cost of Rs 4 core 39 lakh 86 thousand 240. 43 thousand 201 mandays have been generated in Jampuihill block at the cost of Rs 82 lakh 94 thousand 592. 1 lakh 10 thousand 204 mandays have been generated in Laljuri block at the cost of Rs 2 core 11 lakh 59 thousand 168. The office of the D.M, North Tripura, has informed this.

Development works in Jeolchhara ADC village

Construction work of four roads and one irrigation canal has been taken up under MGNREGA in Jeolchhara ADC village of Ambassa block during the current financial year. Construction of two roads and the canal has already been completed. One km. long road from Ramkumar Reangbari to Nilmoni Reangbari has been constructed at the cost of Rs 4 lakh 13 thousand 592 generating 2,126 mandays. Another one km. long road from Arai Mile of Purbarai para to Hatimarachhara para has been constructed at the cost of Rs 2 lakh 48 thousand 280. 1,265 mandays have been generated in this work. Moreover, construction of a 60 metre long canal at Ishanchandrapara has been completed at the cost of Rs 1 lakh 11 thousand 630 generating 1,221 mandays. Moreover, construction of other two mud roads has been started. Rs 8 lakh 88 thousand will be spent for this work and 4625 mandays will be generated in this work. On the other hand, house under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana will be provided to 20 families of the village during the current financial year. Toilets have been constructed for 321 families of the village at the cost of Rs 12,000 per toilet. 334 farmers have benefited under the scheme. The office of the concerned village committee informed this.
