A target has been taken to distribute ORS to total 53,800 children and Zinc tablets to 1,14,800 children of the district. In addition, as a technique of spreading awareness leaflets are being distributed at each spot. ASHA workers will go door to door to ensure no one child of 0-5 year is left out.
