

Philately exhibition in Agartala from February 2

With a view to encouraging philately specially among the young generation the Department of Posts, Agartala Division will be organising a Philatelic Exhibition at Rabindra Shata Barshiki Bhavan from February 2-3. Main attractions of the exhibition will be – Philately Counter and My Stamp Counter. In the first section special covers will be sold on Bhuvaneshwari Temple, Queen pineapple, Hogaigiri Dance, Garia Puja, MBB College and Dipa Karmakar. Apart from these philately kits and philately ancillaries will be there on sale.

Second attraction is a personalised sheet of postage stamp named 'My Stamp'. Personalisation could be achieved by printing a thumb nail image of the customer and logos of institutions or images of artwork, heritage buildings, famous tourist places, historical cities, animals and birds etc. on a selected template sheet having postage stamp. The Agartala Postal Division has invited students and philatelists of the state to participate in the exhibition.

Update on PMAY houses in Sepahijala

Under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana target was set to construct houses for 158 families of Sepahijala district with the fund sanctioned during the last financial year. Under the scheme so far 102 houses have been constructed with a break-up of 32 houses in Bishalgarh block, 23 houses in Boxanagar, 9 in Charilam, 32 in Jampuijala, 16 in Kanthalia, 15 in Mohanbhog and 31 in Nalchhar block. In addition, houses are being constructed for 100 families under TSGHS. This information has been provided by the Sepahijala DM office. During the 2016-17 financial year houses were sanctioned for 1898 families. Out of this 1602 houses have been completed. An amount of Rs. 1.30 lakh has been spent in construction of each house.
