



in Ratanmoni ADC Village of Satchand block on July 29 to provide various administrative facilities to rural people. D.M of South Tripura district Debapriya Bardhan alongwith the officers of various departments visited different areas of Ratanmoni ADC Village. During the visit the administrative team interacted with local people regarding education, health, drinking water, irrigation scheme, nutrition scheme, fisheries, animal husbandry, roads, power, horticultural plantation, forestry, agriculture etc. issues.

D.M also visited few Anganwadi centres of Ratanmoni ADC Village, Shyam Singh S.B School, Manughat PHC and various development project sites. 118 applications for PRTC, 128 applications for ST certificate, 11 applications for marriage certificate and 2 applications for Income certificate were received in the camp. 82 persons were treated and provided required medicine by the health department. Animal resources development department provided various preventive medicines to live stock farmers for treatment of 112 live stock animals and 175 birds. SDM of Sabroom subdivision Biplab Kumar Das and BDO of Satchand block James Darlong were present in the administrative camp.

Meeting on waste management held at Ambassa

A meeting of the district level committee on waste management was organized by Dhalai district administration at the conference hall of D.M office. This work will be started in other Wards within few days. D.M instructed the officers to complete the half-done works by August 15. He instructed the CMO to conduct routine medical check-up of the staffs who are engaged in waste cleaning work. D.M also

instructed to conduct public awareness programme on adverse effects of use of plastic carry bag and governmental prohibitions.
