

Notification in connection with electoral roll for Panchayat-2019

The Electoral Registration Officers (ERO) has notified the schedule for publication of the electoral rolls for all the constituencies of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zilla Parishad for general election to the Panchayats-2019. As per the notification date of publication of draft Electoral Roll of the constituencies of Panchayats will be June, 2019. Last date for filing of claims and objections will be June, 1019. Disposal of claims and objections will be done by June 11, 2019. And the deadline for final publication of the Electoral Roll will be June 21, 2019. It is worth mentioning here that the qualifying date of age for the preparation of Electoral Roll January 1, 2019.

**MGNREGA : 61,546 mandays
generated in North Tripura District**

61,546 mandays have been generated in eight blocks of North Tripura district under MGNREGA during the current financial year. Various development works like land leveling, orchards, construction of rural roads etc have been implemented under the scheme. 8, 524 labourers have got employment through this. Rs one core eight lakh ninety three thousand six hundred forty two has been spent for this purpose. Total 22 lakh 67 thousand 22 mandays had been generated in eight blocks of the district during the last financial year under the scheme. Rs 40 crore 12 lakh 62 thousand 894 has been spent for implementation of these development activities. During the last financial year average 34.17 mandays had been generated in North district.

**14,996 BPL families provided toilet
under Swachh
Bharat Mission in North Tripura**

14,996 BPL families of eight blocks of North Tripura district under Swachh

Bharat Mission rural Scheme and other schemes have been provided toilet free of cost. This work has been done as per base-line survey of 2012. Rs 12,000 has been spent for construction of each toilet. Total Rs 15 core 60 thousand has been spent for this purpose. Under the scheme 609 toilets in Damchhara block, 3,640 toilets in Dasda block, 2,047 toilets in Laljuri block, 474 toilets in Jampuihill block, 2,432 toilets in Panisagar block, 2,594 toilets in Jubarajnar block, 1,746 toilets in Kalachhara block and 1,410 toilets in Kadamtala block have been constructed.
