



now 3 thousand 338 persons have been provided work during this year. In this 22,212 mandays have been generated. House under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana had been provided to 854 families of this block during the last financial year. More 415 families of the block will be provided house under this scheme. Moreover, 10 families of the block have been provided house under Abasan Prakalpa of Government of Tripura. 4,724 families have been provided toilet under Swachh Bharat Mission. Progress of MGNREGA work implemented in various panchayats of the block had been discussed in the meeting. In the review meeting, the representatives of Power, forest, education, fishery, ARD, Social Welfare & Social Education, Agriculture & Farmers Welfare departments highlighted the information of various projects. MLA Ramapada Jamatia stressed on proper implementation of various projects of the departments for the development of common people of the block. He also stressed on to take on Swachh Bharat activity once in a week at any of the schools, market or habitation of this block under Swachh Bharat Mission programme to sensitize the people. Among the others Chairman of Jolaibari Panchayat Samiti Gouri Bhowmik and Chairman of BAC Ankya Mog Chowdhury were present in the meeting.

50 power tillers will be provided to the farmers of Matabari block

Under the chairmanship of Matabari Panchayat Samiti Chairman Rekha Rani Majumder a Joint general meeting of Matabari Panchayat Samiti and BAC was held at the conference hall of Matabari Panchayat Samiti on 4th June. BDO of the block Sourabh Das informed that during the current financial year sanction has been received for construction of 204 houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Rural) in this block till now. Till now, 1 lakh 14

thousand 597 mandays have been generated under MGNREGA scheme. An amount of Rs. 1 crore 98 lakh 82 thousand has been spent for this purpose. The representative of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare department informed that season of cultivation of Aman paddy has been started. For this purpose, sufficient quantity of high yield seeds, fertilizer etc. are stored in the stores and these are being distributed among the farmers. State government will start procuring paddy from the farmers at minimum support price from 11th June. The paddy procurement camp will be held at Dhanya Manikya Mukta Mancha of Matabari. Moreover, a workshop on insurance will be organized at Rajarshi Kalakshetra of Udaipur involving the farmers on that day. An initiative will be taken for distribution of 50 power tillers among the farmers under Matabari Agricultural subdivision. The representative of Fishery department informed that excavation work of four large water tanks in Matabari block had been started in the last financial year. Among these, excavation work of two water tanks have been completed. Initiative has been taken under NDRF for providing Rs. 2,618 each of the 370 fishermen affected during rainy season last year. The representative of PWD(WR) department informed that 41 L.I schemes are there in Matabari block. Out of these 37 schemes are functioning. Moreover, 7 deep-tubewells are there in this area. MLA Ramapada Jamatia instructed the officers of PWD for renovation of the road stretching from Rajnagar to Nityabazar immediately. He also instructed for taking necessary initiatives for renovation of the roads under this block. MLA Biplab Kumar Ghosh, public-representatives of various panchayats and ADC villages, representatives of various departments were present in the meeting.
