

Meeting with MLAs to discuss various development issues

To discuss various development activities in different areas of the state a meeting was held with the MLAs at the secretariat yesterday. Chairing the meeting the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb said, various development activities should be completed within stipulated time frame so that the people could avail of its benefits properly. He also instructed various departments to work in consonance with advice of the concerned MLAs.

Stressing on the need for construction of dam to create water bodies the Chief Minister stated that this would help people in income generation also and the accumulated water could be used as drinking water after purification as well. He instructed the water resources department to take initiative for prevention of soil erosion on the river banks. He also urged the MLAs to be proactive about implementation of the anti-drug mission and supervision of various development schemes like Ujjwala Yojana, Saubhagya Yojana, Ayushman Bharat and so on. In the context of sanction of various development projects from the Central Government and funds the Chief

Minister instructed the respective departments to work in a team.

In the meeting MLAs upheld various problems of their respective areas discussed on various development activities. The issues that found place in their discussion included renovation of roads, construction of bridge and community hall, hostels, development of infrastructure of hostels, construction of school building, supply of necessary equipments to schools, construction of Anganwadi buildings, market shed, setting up of RD Block in Fatikroy, electricity connection, construction of park, opening of border haat etc.

On the basis of the discussed issues the principal secretaries and secretaries of various departments were instructed to take necessary measures. The meeting was also attended by Food Minister Manoj Kanti Deb, Social Welfare and Social Education Minister Santana Chakma, chief secretary Sanjeev Ranjan and other top officials of various departments.
