



Preparation for observance of National De-worming Day in Sepahijala

Along with the State National Deworming Day will be observed in Sepahijala district on 10 August. In 1 thousand 917 centres of this district de-worming medicine will be given to 1 Lakh 47 thousand 790 boys & girls under the age group of 1 year to 19 years. All the preparations have been finalized for this purpose. While speaking in a press conference held in DM's office conference hall on 7 August the DM of Sepahijala Dr. B. Kaur informed this. The DM also informed that de-worming medicine feeding centres will be opened in 634 schools and 1 thousand 283 Anganwadi Centres under this district. On 10 August providing of de-worming medicine in every centre will start from 7 am in the morning. The left out boys & girls who would not be able to feed de-worming medicine on 10 August, they would be provided deworming medicine on 17 and 18 August in nearest schools, Anganwadi centres or colleges. The DM urged all to come forward to make this programme a success.

In the press conference the Sabhadhipati of Sepahijala Zilla Parishad Fakaruddin Ahmed, CMO Dr. Chitan Debbarma, District officer of Social Welfare & Social Education department Dr. Chandrani Biswas including the officials from various departments were present.
