

Commission to visit every district to hear from distressed women

The chairperson of Tripura Commission for Women Barnali Goswami, terming atrocities against women a social malady, has sought cooperation of all for combating this social problem. Addressing the media today at the Commission's office she said, it has been three months that the reconstituted body of the Commission has taken over and in these three months it has been striving to inquire into the incidents related to women and ensure justice to the distressed party, rising above all political considerations. Citing early marriage of girls, dowry transactions etc. as the root causes of various crimes against women she appealed to all guardians to marry off their daughters only when they are mature enough.

Smt. Goswami also informed, from next month onward the Commission will visit every district to listen to the woes of women. Because there are many women who cannot afford to come to Agartala to place their submissions before the Commission. The schedule of the visits will be publicized in advance. She said, although there are some sporadic incidents of atrocities on women the police are extending their all-out cooperation in this regard.

Government declares revised Pay for employees

The Council of Ministers, in a special meeting held today, has approved implementation of the recommendations of the 3-member Expert Committee for revision of Pay/Wages / Honorarium/Pensions etc.. As per the cabinet decision the Revision of Pay/Wages / Pensions will come into effect from October 1, 2018. It is worth mentioning here that the new government in its first meeting constituted this 3-member Expert Committee in consonance with its Vision Document. This decision was conveyed to the media at a press conference held at the state secretariat this evening. The press conference was attended by the Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb, Deputy Chief Minister Jishnu Dev Varma, Revenue Minister N.C. Debbarma, Health Minister Sudip Roy Barman, and Education Minister Ratan Lal Nath.

It was informed that in case of regular employees the new pay structure shall be in the form of "Tripura State Pay Matrix 2018" which will replace the "Tripura State Pay Matrix 2017". According to the new pay matrix the multiplication factor shall be raised from previous 2.25 to 2.57 generally subject to certain conditions to
