Preparation for Ratha Yatra Festival in Udaipur

As per tradition this year also Ratha Yatra Festival will be organized at Udaipur on July 14. In this context a preparatory meeting was held in the office chamber of the Subdivisional Magistrate of Udaipur on July 4. In that meeting Additional Subdivisional Magistrate Subrata Majumder along with officials from various departments viz. PWD, DWS, Power, ICA, Police and members of Ratha Yatra Committee were present. It has been informed in the meeting that on July 14 at 3 pm the Ratha Yatra rally, beginning from Jagannath Bari, would move around the different streets of the city only to conclude at Shibbari. To make this event successful steering committee and sub-committees have been formed.

Assistance provided for cultivation of fish in Hejamara block

Various programmes are being implemented by Mohanpur fishery superintendent for increasing production of fish as a part of 100 days programme. Nylon fishing net was distributed among 6 fishermen belonging to S.C community of Hejamara block at the cost of Rs 5,790 under this programme. 100 young *pabda* fishes were distributed among 10 fishermen at the cost of Rs 6,000 under *pabda* fish cultivation programme. 200 young spawns (prawn) were distributed among 20 fish farmers each at the cost of Rs 12,000. Seeds

of 800 C C Rui ,Katla and Mrigel fish were distributed among 11 fish farmers at the cost of Rs 39,160. Moreover, 100 fish farmers have been trained in scientific fish cultivation.

Assistance to fish cultivators in Bishalgarh

Assistance under various schemes is being provided to the fish cultivators to increase fish production in Bishalgarh Block area. The work of providing assistance to 43 families under seasonal fish cultivation scheme, 4 families under fish feed production scheme, 20 families under prawn cultivation scheme, 10 families under *pabda* fish cultivation scheme, 43 families under fish cultivation in small water bodies scheme, 3 families under fish cultivation in remote areas scheme and 125 families under fish seeds production scheme is in progress. Apart from this, training of 380 farmers is in progress to make them skillful in scientific fish farming.

Additional class rooms in 5 schools of Bamutia

Construction of additional classrooms is going on in various schools of Bamutia block under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan. These constructions are - 4 class rooms in Patunagar High School, 4 class rooms in Rajnagar Gandhigram High School, 2 class rooms in Dugangi J.B School, 2 classrooms in Tebaria High School and 3 class rooms in Berimura H.S School. Rs 7.20 lakh will be spent for construction of each classroom. Total cost of the constructions will be Rs 1 crore 8 lakh.
