Water ATM at 10 places of Agartala city

Water ATMs have been installed at ten places of Agartala city. This project was officially inaugurated by MP Pratima Bhowmik at Agartala City Centre on November 2 under Smart City Mission. These water ATMs have been installed at state secretariat, Gorkhabasti, City Centre, TMC, Dimsagar, Radhanagar, ILS Hospital, GBP Hospital, Nagerjala and Golbazar. An amount of Rs. 1, 11, 40,000 has been spent for this purpose.
