Water reservoir to be created under PM Krishi Sinchai Yojana in Gomati district

95 water reservoirs will be dug by the agriculture and farmers welfare department in Gomati district under PM Kishan Sinchai Yojana during the current financial year for irrigation purpose.

Among these, 19 reservoirs in Matabari block, 6 reservoirs in Tepania block, 11 reservoirs in Kakraban block, 11 reservoirs in Amarpur block, 13 reservoirs in Ampi block, 12 reservoirs in Karbook block, 8 reservoirs in Shilachhari block will be created.
