

Road renovation in Sonamura

A 17.295 km. stretch of Melaghar – Kanthalia road is being renovated. Protection wall and drains are also being constructed on two sides of the road. An amount of Rs. 7,37,37,000 will be required for this work. So far work for 7 km. has been completed. Similarly 3 km. stretch of North Jalibari-Gamaichera road is being renovated. Rs. 2,10,00,000 will be spent in this work. This information has been given by the Sonamura office of the executive engineer of PWD.

66th Cooperative Week observed in state

About eight lakh people of the state area associated with co-operative societies. The number of cooperative societies rose to 1957 by 2018-19 which was 1793 in 2017-18. And by October, 2019-20 number of cooperative societies has reached 2875 mark. At the same time number of NGOs has risen considerably to reach 8092 mark by 2018-19. To be successful these cooperative societies have to formulate their plans and work in consonance with the development plans formulated by the state government, stated the chief minister Biplab Kumar Deb after inaugurating a seminar on “Role of Cooperatives in New India” organized on

the occasion of 66th All India Cooperative Week yesterday at Agartala Town Hall.

Gracing the programme as the chief guest the education minister Ratan Lal Nath said, co-operative means ‘not to exclude anybody’. These cooperatives have immense role in incorporating the poor people of the villages in the gambit of income flow. The programme was also attended by the agriculture minister Pranajit Singha Roy as the guest of honour, MLA Brishaketu Debbarma, chief secretary U. Venkateswaralu and representatives of different cooperative societies.

On this occasion a leaflet and Samabai Samachar were released by the chief minister. A documentary was also screened by the department. In addition, RuPay, KCC card, Micro ATM and loan sanction letter etc. were handed over to the members of PACKS. The chief minister also distributed prizes among the rank-holders in a speech competition organized in connection with this. On behalf of Durgabari Tea Estate Workers Co-operative Society scholarship was handed over to two people.

Drinking water sources created under SC Welfare department fund

Three market stalls have been constructed by SC welfare department in West Tripura district. These stalls have been constructed in Marakpara in Tulacona gaon panchayat under Old Agartala block, Domdamia of Bamutia block and East Gandhigram at the cost of Rs 30 lakh. Moreover, a mini deep tube well in Harijan colony of Bhati Abhoynagar in Sadar subdivision and a deep tube well in Dushmanta para of Bankimnagar G.P of Jirania block have been installed on behalf of S.C welfare department. Submergible pump and 500 metre long pipe line have been installed in Bijohnagar, Rangachhara and Simna of Mohanpur block on behalf of S.C welfare department. The officer of the West district S.C welfare office has informed that one fishing net (Koni jaal) had been provided to each of 1784 S.C fisherman families of Old Agartala, Jirania, Dukli, Mohanpur, Hejamara and Bamutia blocks. One fishing net (Ber jaal) had been provided to 82 S.C fisherman families during the last financial year.

Deep tube well for irrigation purpose in Dasda block
