

NF Railway to have special train services for Diwali Mela

In view of the coming Diwali Festival celebrations at Tripureswari Temple in Udaipur the NF Railway, Lumding division has decided to run special trains on the Dharmanagar-Agartala-Udaipur-Sabroom route from October 27-29. As per schedule, Dharmanagar-Agartala-Udaipur special train will start from Dharmanagar at 6 pm. to Agartala at 10 pm. Again starting from Agartala at 10.05 pm the train will reach Udaipur at 11.5 pm. on the other hand, the Udaipur-Agartala- Dharmanagar special will start from Udaipur at 5.30 am. to reach Agartala 6.30 am. From Agartala this train will start at 7 am. to reach Dharmanagar at 11 am. This special train will halt for 2 minutes at Kumarghat, Manu, Ambassa, Teliamura and Jirania stations and at other stations it will stop for 1 minute only.

In addition, for the convenience of the pilgrims, train no. 07681 will start at 10 pm of 27th and 29th October from Sabroom to reach Udaipur at 11 pm. The same train will reach Agartala at 12.30 am. It is worth mentioning that the train no 07681 will run on the Sarboom-Agartala route regularly. The transport department has informed this

through an official statement.

New motor-boats distributed for disaster management

As a part of the observance of International Disaster Reduction Day- 2019, 40 rubber boats were distributed today at Durgabari temple premises,

Agartala, by the revenue department. The department distributed these motor-run boats among five districts, 10 TSR battalions including fire service, central training institute, Assam Rifles, BSF and Red Cross Society. The revenue minister Narendra Chandra Debbarma was present there as the chief guest.

Addressing the gathering the minister said, apart from distribution of necessary modern equipments for disaster management, workshops are also being organized. Attending the programme the revenue department secretary B.K. Sahu said, initiative has also been taken to provide drone, night vision camera, body harness etc. for better equipping the disaster management force. Apart from the boats, 480 life-jackets and other rescue materials were also distributed. For this, an amount of Rs. 1.74 crore has been spent. At present, with the coming of these new boats the fleet of motor-run boats has come to 80 while, nonmotorised boats at disposal are 56.

110 power tillers distributed in Gomati district

Under the aegis of horticulture and soil conservation department 110 powertillers have been distributed among farmers of Gomati district during the 2018-19 financial year under MIDH scheme. Among

the beneficiaries 16 people were from Amarapur block, 15 beneficiaries from Matabari block, 16 beneficiaries from Kakraban Block, 15 beneficiaries from Tepania block, 16 beneficiaries from Ampa block, 12 beneficiaries from Killa block, 10 beneficiaries from Karbook block and 10 beneficiaries from Silachari block.
