

Inauguration of new building of Kalyanpur H.S School; State government taken 21 new projects in development of education: C.M

Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb inaugurated new building of Kalyanpur H.S School of Khowai district on Feb 12. Education Minister Ratanlal Nath, Chief Whip of TLA Kalyani Roy, MLA Pinaki Das Chowdhury, Secretary of Tripura Sports Council Amit Rakshit, D.M of Khowai district Smita Mol were present in the programme. Chief Minister said that the present state government is giving maximum emphasis towards education and to impart quality education 21 new projects were introduced in this sector in just 23 months. Syllabus of NCERT has been introduced in the state. Emphasis has given on centralized examination, teacher-guardian counseling etc. The present state government has taken various initiatives including introduction of 30 new schools, conversion of 28 Bengali medium Schools to English medium schools, merging of students of those schools where students were less than 25 into a large school. Transportation fee has also been provided to the students for better convenience. Academic session has been started from April-March as the students of the state can participate in national level competition. Special classes for 30 days will be conducted before final examination for those students who did not secured good result in half-yearly

examination. 337 houses have already been provided to the beneficiaries of Kalyanpur under PM Awas Yojana. 2083 toilets have been constructed in Kalyanpur under Swaach Bharat. Construction of 800 more toilets is going on. Number of mandays under MGNREGA has been increased up to 4 lakh 32and 329 during 2019-20 financial year.10000 cards have already been provided to the beneficiaries in Kalyanpur under Ayushman Bharat. Rs 6000 have been provided to 2154 families of this area in three installments under PM Kishan Yojana.LPG has been provided to 5315 families of this area under Ujjala Gas Yojana. Installation of deep tube well in 7 places and prevention of soil erosion in 4 places have done in this area. Durgapur and Kamalnagar villages of Kalyanpur have been selected Under Adarsha Gram Yojana. The inhabitants of Kalyanpur will get facility of 30 bedded P.H.C in future. Education Minister Ratanlal Nath expressed that C.M Merit Award of Academic Excellence has been introduced for good academic carrier. At present library facility is available in different schools. NCERT has been taken arrangement for providing training to 30000 teachers. Seven more colleges will be established and integrated B.Ed course will be introduced. Education loan has been arranged by bank for poor students under Chief Minister B.Ed Anuprerana Yojana. The state government will bear interest of the loan.

Moreover, 2 private Universities will be introduced for development of education system. MLA Pinaki Das Chowdhury delivered speech. It is also mentioned that Rs 5 crore 64 lakh has been spent for construction of new building of the school. As a part of the programme, the students of NSS unit of Kalyanpur H.S School handed over the cheque of Rs 16000 to Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb for Chief Minister Relief Fund. Assistant Headmistress Anjana Debbarma of Kalyanpur H.S School delivered welcome address. The programme was presided over by Chairman of SMC Kanai Shil.

State government taken special initiative to increase income of small & marginal farmers and become economically self dependent: D.M

Niddhi Yojana. A target has been taken that those farmers have not availed Kishan credit card they will be registered within Feb 23. He also added that those farmers have availed loan through KCC they can also avail loan for animal husbandry and fish cultivation in necessary.
